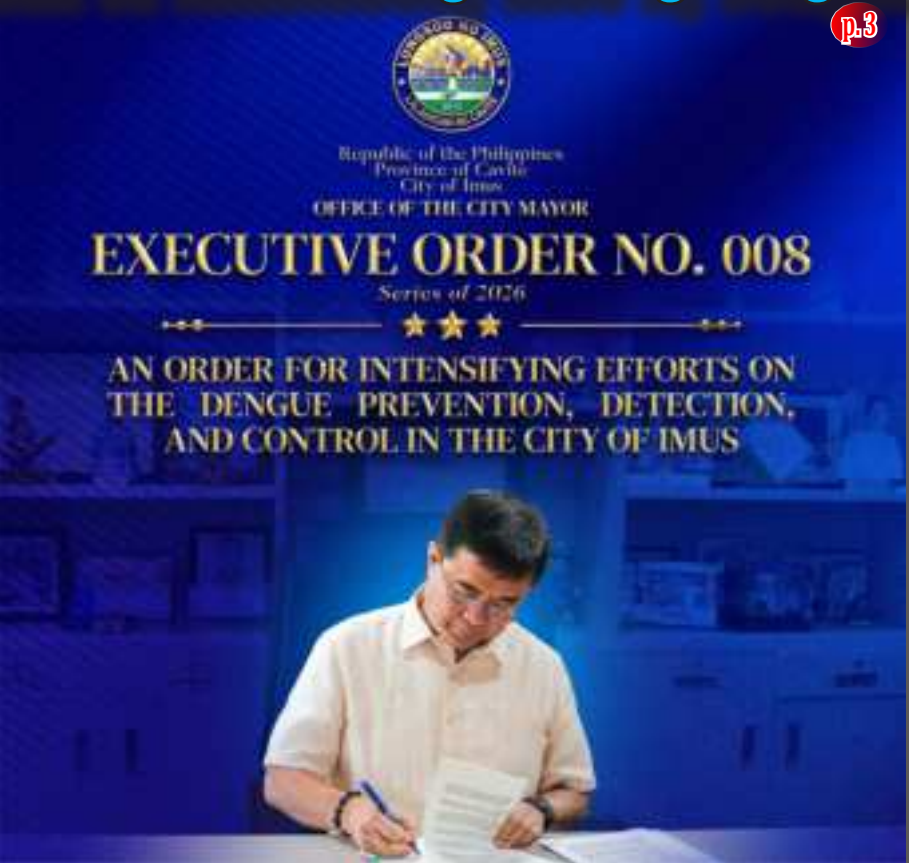

## DTI Laguna Supports Launch of Siniloan Convergence Area Development Plan (CADP)

Siniloan, Laguna — The Department of Trade and Industry–Laguna (DTI Laguna), led by Provincial Director Christian Ted O. Tungohan, together with Assistant Regional Director Revelyn A. Cortez of DTI CALABARZON (DTI 4-A), participated in the launch of the Siniloan Convergence Area Development Plan (CADP) at the Siniloan Cultural Center in Siniloan, Laguna on January 22, 2026.

The activity formally marked the commencement of the Siniloan CADP's implementation, a strategic framework aimed at advancing inclusive and sustainable rural development through strengthened convergence and collaboration among national government agencies, the local government unit, and key stakeholders in the municipality.

During the program, a comprehensive presentation of the Siniloan Convergence Area Development Plan was presented, outlining its development objectives, priority sectors, and planned interventions. These initiatives are geared toward enhancing local economic development, promoting livelihood opportunities, and ensuring environmental sustainability within the convergence area.

The launching, led by the Local Government
