SAN JOSE, Antique (PIA) — The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)- Antique Provincial Statistical Office signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Social Security System (SSS) Antique Branch to implement a collective agency enrollment and remittance system.

PSA Chief Statistical Specialist Randy Tacogdoy said that this milestone is achieved under the KaltaSSS-Collect Program of the SSS, marking a significant step in providing a robust social safety net for Job Order (JO) and Contract of Service (COS) workers within the PSA to ensure they are no longer left behind in terms of insurance and future security.

The partnership addresses a critical gap in the government workforce that excludes JOs and COS from the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), citing the absence of a formal employer-employee relationship under civil service rules. Under the KaltaSSS-Collect Program, JOs and COs

are classified as self-employed members of the SSS, granting them a legal pathway to obtain social security benefits.

Senior Statistical Specialist and Environmental Planner Jeffrey G. Conlu, in a news release, said that by formalizing this collective agency enrollment, PSA Antique ensures that its frontline personnel and administrative support staff enjoy the same protections as their counterparts in the private sector.

Likewise, Tacogdoy emphasized that this milestone is a long-overdue achievement for the welfare of the agency's personnel.

He noted that the MOA is a decisive move to ensure that every individual contributing to PSA's mission, regardless of their employment status, is anchored by reliable social protection.

Central to this partnership is the streamlined remittance process, which utilizes an automatic payroll deduction scheme to guarantee consistent contributions.

Beyond simple compliance, this collective enrollment opens the door to a comprehensive suite of SSS benefits, including sickness, maternity, disability, and retirement pensions.

Members will also be eligible for death and funeral benefits, as well as access to salary and calamity loans, to assist them during times of financial need.



Tacogdoy also underscored that this collaboration reflects a shared commitment between the PSA and SSS to promote the welfare of government workers, recognizing their vital role in public service by providing them with the dignity of long-term financial security and protection against unforeseen contingencies.

DENR strengthens Boracay oversight, tightens environmental clearance

MANILA – The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) has strengthened environmental oversight on Boracay Island and tightened its rules on the processing and issuance of Environmental Compliance Certificates (ECC) and Certificates of Non-Coverage (CNC).

In a news release Wednesday, the DENR said the agency has ordered a stricter review of all development projects, through Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2025-36, to safeguard the island's ecological limits, in line with its continuing rehabilitation and sustainable management.

"In pursuit of this policy, all projects within the island of Boracay shall be evaluated in consideration of the island's physical and ecological limits to ensure its sustainability," the DAO read.

"The primary objective of this Administrative Order is to provide guidelines on the evaluation of the carrying capacity and geological hazards on Boracay Island in the review and processing of ECC and CNC applications."

The DENR said the guidelines provide standards for evaluating carrying capacity and geological hazards in the review and processing of ECC and CNC applications and applies to all existing projects, expansion projects, and new developments on the island that fall within the purview of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) System, as well as new and existing structures that qualify for the issuance of a CNC.

Applicants are re-

quired to submit an EIS or Initial Environmental Examination (IEE) Checklist, land-use compatibility certification from the local government, proof of land authority, easement compliance documents, and geohazard reports endorsed by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB).

New projects, meanwhile, must also obtain carrying capacity endorsements from the Ecosystems Research and Development Bureau (ERDB).

The DENR said only projects aligned with Boracay's approved land use and zoning framework will be eligible for environmental clearance.

Smaller undertakings not covered by the EIS System, like residential houses, small businesses, places of worship, and minor public infrastructure, must secure a CNC.

All CNC applications will be processed manually at the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) Region VI to allow on-site validation.

The order also imposes strict environmental conditions, including mandatory wastewater treatment, compliance with national water quality standards, proper solid waste management in coordination with the Malay local government, and adherence to island traffic policies.

The DENR said the measure ensures that future development on Boracay proceeds under tighter environmental controls while preserving the gains achieved from the island's rehabilitation done in 2018. (PNA)

The newly opened facilities include the Macrohon Post Office, located at the Municipal Hall in Barangay San Vicente (Poblacion), Macrohon, Southern Leyte;

the Matina Davao City Post Office along General Douglas MacArthur Highway in Matina Crossing, Davao City; the Limasawa Island Post Office in Southern Leyte; and the Baco Postal Station in the Municipality of Baco, Oriental Mindoro.

PHLPost added that these strategic branch openings form part of the corporation's sustained efforts to strengthen its nationwide network and ensure that essential postal and logistics services reach Filipinos wherever they are, link communities nationwide, and support national development.
