With this milestone, the operational length of CALAX now spans 26 kilometers from the Mamplasan Entry in Biñan, Laguna.

The entire 44.6-kilometer CALAX project, will eventually link the Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX) in Kawit to the South Luzon Expressway (SLEX) in Mamplasan. CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY (PIA) — The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation-Northern Mindanao's (PhilHealth-10) massive benefit expansion for cancer and kidney disease is now shielding patients from the crushing costs of specialized treatment, implementing the healthcare commitment of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. for every Filipino.

In a press conference on May 5, PhilHealth-10 Regional Vice President Delio A. Aseron II announced its Z benefit package worth up to P1.4 million for treatment of stages zero to four of breast cancer. For early stages of colon cancer, PhilHealth offers a benefit package of treatment worth P150,000, and up to P300,000 for advanced, high-risk stages (Stage 2 to 3) of said illness.

Members may also avail of other benefit packages, including coverage of up to P400,000 for rectum cancer, P175,000 for cervical cancer, and P500,000 for acute lymphocytic leukemia in children.



Recognizing kidney disease as a leading health concern in the Philippines, PhilHealth has also increased its benefit package, now covering up to P2.1 million for a kidney transplant operation, and up to P1.2 million for peritoneal dialysis.

Aseron said PhilHealth now also covers a total of 156 hemodialysis sessions a year, at P6,350 per session.

Kapag Chronic Kidney Disease Stage 5 ka, three times a week kang dina-dialysis. Meaning, sa 156 sessions, sagot na ng PhilHealth ang [hemodialysis sa] buong taon," Aseron said, emphasizing PhilHealth's role as a partner for Filipinos in all stages of treatment.

He said PhilHealth is also intensifying its promotion of the Outpatient Emergency Care Benefits, which cover the cost for emergency outpatient services and related expenses for patients who receive treatment but do not need hospital admission.

"This is part of our ongoing goal—to make PhilHealth services simpler, faster, and more comforting," Aseron said. (GDA/PIA-10)
