CALAX is a 44.6-kilometer expressway connecting the provinces of Cavite and Laguna. Once completed, it is expected to serve approximately 95,000 motorists daily. Currently, its operational segments span from Biñan, Laguna to General Trias, Cavite, significantly reducing travel time from an hour to just 26 minutes.

Beyond improving mobility, CALAX also advances environmental sustainability by helping reduce fuel consumption and vehicle emissions through shorter travel times. Its green initiatives include the integration of solar power systems, rainwater harvesting facilities, and the progressive transition of its corporate fleet to electric vehicles (EVs), reinforcing the company's commitment to responsible and sustainable expressway operations.

The Commission on Elections (Comelec) on Wednesday said it is fully prepared for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) parliamentary elections on 14 September and the special election in Cavite's 4th Legislative District on 29 August. Comelec Chairman George Erwin Garcia said the campaign period for both elections begins on 30 July, urging candidates to strictly comply with election rules and regulations. "Sa mga kababayan natin sa Bangsamoro, simula na po bukas ng kampanyahan. Ang pakiusap natin sa mga kandidato, i-observe po natin ang campaign rules and regulations. At sana po ang paggamit ng mga non-biodegradable materials ay iwasan natin," Garcia said.

Garcia said he and other Comelec commissioners will travel to Marawi City to monitor the opening of the campaign period and ensure compliance with election rules.

He warned candidates against using government resources for campaign activities and encouraged the public to report election violations.

"We will disqualify candidates who will violate. So again, do not abuse state resources. We will not hesitate to disqualify candidates and at the same time file appropriate criminal charges against them," Garcia said.

The Comelec chief also said the poll body will hold its final coordination meeting Thursday with the Armed Forces of the Philippines and the Philippine National Police

as part of election security preparations. Garcia reiterated his appeal for candidates to avoid using non-biodegradable campaign materials as part of the poll body's environmental campaign.

Meanwhile, Comelec has completed the verification of ballots for both elections. Garcia said less than one percent of the ballots were found defective and have already been reprinted.

The commission is now repacking the ballots for distribution to polling precincts, along with the automated counting machines, which are expected to be ready by the first week of August./DT

BACOR CITY, Cavite (PIA) — The Bawat Bayan Makikinabang Rice Augmentation Program promises relief for Bacoor City families for their daily meals.

As part of the Local Government Support Fund (LGSF), a priority initiative of the Office of the President through the Office of the Executive Secretary, the Bawat Bayan Makikinabang Rice Program rollout in Bacoor City aimed to provide 10 kilos of rice to around 10,000 individuals.

MANILA, Philippines — The Department of Transportation (DOTr) will continue the construction of Zapote and Niog stations of the Light Rail Transit 1 – Cavite Extension Project if the Villar Group of Companies will

refuse to settle with the agency's offer, its Secretary Giovanni Lopez said on Thursday.

According to Lopez, the DOTr will meet with the Villar Group next week in relation to its donation of six parcels of land where



the Las Piñas station of the extension project will be built.

Lopez said that the conditions are: to give DOTr an unconditional permit to enter; the land to be part of deed donation and to free the government from any liability; and cancellation of the mortgage on the land to be donated. "It's a take it or leave it offer. They have to decide for the take it or leave it terms.

The reason why I am saying this now is for them to decide if our meeting pushes through next week," Lopez said in an interview with True FM.

Lopez earlier dismissed claims that the Villar family blocked the Cavite Extension project,

saying that there were no issues with right-of-way acquisition for the project. He also said that the family wanted to donate their land.

"Because once they will refuse the offer of the government, these three non-negotiable from DOTr and LRTA, we have no problem with the alignment, but we have a problem with the station.

If the Villar group of companies refuse, I will order the continuation of the construction all the way to Zapote and Niog.

We will set aside Las Piñas for a while. Because it would be unfair to the community of Zapote and Bacoor to be held hostage by the issue on Las

Pinas," Lopez added. He explained that the DOTr needs 8,389 square meters (sqm) of land to construct the Las Piñas and Zapote stations, noting that about 4,990 sqm are supposed to be donated by the Villars for the construction of the Las Piñas station. However, Lopez shared that of the six parcels of land they need from the Villars, two of them are under mortgage. Said that one of the two parcels under mortgage in Chinabank spans more or less 2,000 or 3,000 sqm while the other one is 90 sqm for a viaduct.

Lopez also said that an owner of a land under encumbrance can still sell or donate it, noting that "it

does not affect the powers and rights of the owner." However, as the land will be donated to the government, he said that the government must be free from any liability. "The government's obligation is to ensure that there is no risk on its part so the commuting public won't be affected. That's what I am saying that is under negotiation," he added.

As the LRT-1 Cavite Extension Project broke ground in 2019, the completion of Las Piñas, Zapote, and Niog stations will bring the total train stations to 28. The LRT-1 currently runs from Fernando Poe Jr. station in Quezon City to Dr. Santos station in Parañaque City. /PR

PCSO contributions to PhilHealth to reach P13.98 billion

MANDALUYONG CITY — The Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) Board on Tuesday, July 28, approved an additional P1.16-billion contribution to the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) for 2026 pursuant to the Universal Health Care Act, raising the agency's total contribution for the year to P3.85 billion.

The revised contribution is expected to bring PCSO's cumulative remittances to PhilHealth since 2022 to approximately P13.98 billion by the end of 2026. PCSO has already remitted a total of P11.47 billion through the Bureau of the Treasury since 2022. The agency remitted P2.71 billion in 2022, P2 billion in 2023, P2.13 billion in 2024, P2.87 billion in 2025 and P1.94 billion in the first half of 2026. Another P2.51 billion is projected to be remitted during the second half of 2026, bringing PCSO's cumulative contributions to approximately P13.98 billion by year-end.

PCSO General Manager Melquiades A. Robles said the agency's contributions help strengthen the

health protection available to Filipino patients and their families, particularly when medical expenses place a heavy burden on household finances.

"Behind these figures are Filipino families who depend on PhilHealth when a loved one is hospitalized or needs medical treatment. In support of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.'s healthcare agenda, PCSO's contribution helps strengthen the system that protects Filipinos from having to shoulder the full cost of health care on their own," Robles said. Under the Universal Health Care Act, PCSO is mandated to allocate 40 percent of its Charity Fund to support the implementation of UHC. These funds help sustain and improve health benefits for PhilHealth members and their

qualified dependents.

Robles said PCSO's compliance with the law is closely tied to its broader mandate of providing health and charitable assistance to the Filipino people.

"This is not simply a financial obligation for PCSO. It is part of our responsibility to ensure that the revenues generated by the agency are returned to the people in ways that protect their health, preserve their dignity and give families one less burden to carry during difficult times," he said.

PCSO's contributions to PhilHealth complement its direct medical and charitable assistance programs for patients requiring hospitalization, medicines, diagnostic procedures and other health-related services./PIA
